Look what we've achieved so far!

Along with our sponsors, partners and volunteers we've been working hard to make our project a reality. We installed drip deflectors so that any water entering the tunnel, will not damage our mural.With lots of help from the Ayrshire Coastal Path volunteers and others, we jet washed the tunnel walls and ceiling.

Ayrshire College Painting and Decorating pre-apprentice students completed the masonry painting. HNC/D Art and Design students have helped paint the Ayr market scene mural. We've fitted CCTV to monitor and deter unwanted activity in the tunnel. The Restorative Justice team has also made a great contribution by helping to clean the walls and preparing the mural boards.

In March, we installed the first part of our mural and we've had amazing feedback from everyone that has been involved and all the new visitors to the tunnel.


